

Ivanhoe Way Challenge Challenge In Aid Of Wishes 4 Kids

The Mayor of Ashby Richard Bebbington, and his wife Angela, are pleased to announce applications for the 4th annual Ivanhoe Way Challenge are now open. The challenge, to walk the 37 mile Ivanhoe Way route within 15 hours, takes place on Saturday 16th June 2012. Since the event was launched over 100 people have completed the challenge, raising thousands for a Leicestershire Charity, Wishes 4 Kids.

Starting at The Royal Hotel in Ashby De La Zouch, the route passes Staunton Harold Reservoir, through the rocky outcrops of Charnwood Forest, out to Bagworth, and back along the route of the Ashby Canal, via Shackerstone. Once back in Ashby there will be a well earned meal and drink waiting for the walkers at The Royal Hotel.

There is an administration fee of £17.50 per application and each participant is encouraged to raise sponsorship for Wishes 4 Kids. There has been lots of interest already for this year's challenge and with places limited to 100 early applications are advised.
