- 128/2008 APOLOGIES**
Apologies were received from Cllr Kelly.
- 129/2008 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

- 130/2008 REPORT FROM THE POLICE**
There were no representatives from the Police in attendance.

- 132/2008 MINUTES OF THE LAST PARISH COUNCIL MEETING**
The minutes of the Parish Council Meetings held on 18th February 2009, which had previously been circulated to all Members, required changes and would be signed off at the next meeting.
- 133/2008 MATTERS ARISING**
THE PLACING OF SALT BINS WITHIN THE PARISH
The Clerk had checked all the details with LCC Highways and they had confirmed that it was the Parish Councils responsibility to purchase the bins, these would then be kept stocked by Highways at no additional cost. The Clerk was informed that once locations had been decided upon, its was the responsibly of the Parish Council to write to any residents who live within the vicinity of the salt bin, to ask for their confirmation that they were happy for them to be placed there. The Clerk has site visits planned for the Recreation Ground and planned to visit the Parish and suggested sites to look for suitable locations.

She felt that it would be useful to have more history about Coleotron on the website. The Clerk had contacted Mr Smith with the suggested kissing gate to see whether this type of gate would be suitable.

PLAY EQUIPMENT UPDATE

The Clerk had attended two site meetings with Play Equipment providers to look at possibilities and options for this parcel of land. This was mainly concentrating on the 0-8 year old children. The providers had taken measurements on the area. The Clerk had received one set of plans which the Council perused and acknowledged. This item will be carried forward to the next meeting when it is hoped that a further set of plans will be available for comparison.
